## SCHOLARSHIP



### FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

#### A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. Applicant must be a <u>senior</u> and eligible to graduate and on track to enroll and <u>be accepted in a construction or</u> <u>manufacturing-related degree program</u> in a SACS-accredited community college, four-year college or university, or MCEF apprenticeship program.
- 2. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4 point scale.

#### **B.** REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of the following items are submitted as one package and <u>post-marked</u> no later than **April 19, 2024.** 
  - a. A fully completed application form.
  - b. **Three letters of recommendation**: One Personal and Two Academic (Academic may include: Instructor, Director, Principal or Coach).
  - c. Submit a maximum of **200-words, essay** that explains why you are going into the construction or manufacturing industry and what this career path means to you.
  - d. **Official high school transcripts.** (*Grade reports will not be accepted*) Note: Official high school transcripts may be submitted separate of fully completed application; however, official transcripts must be received by the scholarship deadline.
  - e. At least **2 pictures** of the applicant participating in school, trade, or volunteer activities. Pictures may be attached and mailed with applications or emailed directly to <a href="mailto:katie.canterbury@mcef.net">katie.canterbury@mcef.net</a>. Please make sure both pictures are of the applicant and that he/she is readily identifiable in the submitted pictures.

#### C. AWARDS

- 1. A successful applicant will receive up to \$500.00 in funds paid directly to the enrolling institution of higher learning or to MCEF apprenticeship. The scholarship will be a one-time award.
- 2. Applications will be reviewed, and recipients selected by the MCEF/SBOC Scholarship Committee which will consider the applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, and letters of recommendation.
- 3. Awards will be presented to the scholarship recipients during the MCEF Awards Day Program on Friday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024. If chosen, scholarship recipients will be notified in advance to ensure their presence at the MCEF Awards Day Program. Please make sure that contact information is correct on application.

Applicant must ensure that the application, letters of recommendation and official transcripts, and required attachments are post marked by the <u>April 19, 2024</u>, deadline.
